Pat had a background in accounting, finance, and insurance. She practiced as a tax professional for over 39 years. Opening the Tax Professionals, Inc. in 2005, her business specialized in tax preparation, accounting, and representing her clients before the Internal Revenue Service and state tax authorities.

Her many accomplishments consist of being one of the leading tax preparation instructors in northern New Mexico, she wrote the first instructional workbook for preparing New Mexico taxes. Awards and accolades include National Association of Enrolled Agents (NAEA) Excellence in Education Award, she participated in the development of the Secretary of State's "One Stop Business Portal" project, and the 2016 NAEA Outstanding Volunteer Award. She received honor and recognition for her work in tax education, her strong working relationship with New Mexico tax departments, her service on the national Ethics Committee, and her continued support for NAEA's government relations. Pat was a member and active participant of NAEA, the National Association of Tax Professionals, the National Society of Accountants, and many state affiliates of NAEA.
